

# Different Gifts: The Same Spirit

The Diocese of Wollongong is celebrating the International Day of People with a DisAbility on 3rd December in fine form.

At the meeting of the Council for People with Disabilities and their Families on 2nd December, Bishop Peter Ingham will be presented with a report entitled DIFFERENT GIFTS: THE SAME SPIRIT.

This report is the outcome of a twenty-month Action-Research Project, which implemented the Office of Disability for the Diocese of Wollongong. Throughout the Diocese of Wollongong a number of parishes will acknowledge the international day during the Sunday liturgy, and display posters and resources offering information to families who have members with a disability. There will be two Awareness Masses; one at St Frances Xavier's Cathedral in Wollongong and the other at St Michael's Parish Church in Nowra. These Eucharistic celebrations will provide opportunities for people with disability to participate fully in the liturgy and share their many gifts.
